


CENACLE PRAYER BOOKLET

Leader: Open our lips O Lord

Response: And our mouths shall declare your praise

Leader: O God, come to our assistance

Response: O Lord, make haste to help us

Leader: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Response: As it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be world without end. AMEN

THE APOSTLE'S CREED

All: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord. Who was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into Hell. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. AMEN.

OUR FATHER

Leader: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy Name, Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Response: Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. AMEN

HAIL MARY (recite 3 times)

Leader: Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

Response: Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now, and at the hour of our death. AMEN

GLORY BE

Leader: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Response: As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. AMEN

OH MY JESUS

All: O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy.

Leader: St Joseph

Response: Pray for us.

All: Come Holy Spirit, come by the means of the powerful intercession, of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, your well beloved spouse.

All: O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, All Praise & All Thanksgiving be every moment thine.

*****Announce the mystery and the prayer intention dedicated for the mystery then recite the decade following:***

Large bead - 1 x Our Father

Small beads - 10 x Hail Mary

1 x Glory Be

1 x Oh My Jesus

1 x St Joseph

1 x Come Holy Spirit

1 x O Sacrament

*****To be recited on Mondays & Saturdays*****

1st Mystery - The Annunciation of Angel Gabriel to Mary

2nd Mystery – The Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth

3rd Mystery – The Birth of our Lord Jesus Christ

4th Mystery – The Presentation of Jesus to the temple

5th Mystery – The Finding of the child Jesus in the temple

SORROWFUL MYSTERIES:

*****To be recited on Tuesdays & Fridays*****

1st Mystery – The Agony of Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane

2nd Mystery – The Scourging of Jesus at the pillar

3rd Mystery – The Crowning with thorns

4th Mystery – The Carrying of the Cross

5th Mystery – The Crucifixion & death of Our Lord Jesus Christ

GLORIOUS MYSTERIES:

*****To be recited on Wednesdays & Sundays*****

1st Mystery – The Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ

2nd Mystery – The Ascension of Jesus Christ to Heaven

3rd Mystery – The Descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles & the Blessed Virgin Mary

4th Mystery – The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven

5th Mystery – The Coronation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Queen as Heaven and Earth

LUMINOUS MYSTERIES:

*****To be recited on Thursdays*****

1st Mystery – The Baptism of Jesus in the river Jordan

2nd Mystery – The Wedding at Cana

3rd Mystery – The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God

4th Mystery – The Transfiguration

5th Mystery – The Institution of the Eucharist

PRAYER INTENTIONS PER MYSTERY:

*****To be read after mystery has been announced*****

First Mystery - Let us offer the first mystery for the Church, for Pope Francis, all archbishops and priests. Jesus the good shepherd, give them deep faith, firm hope and burning love to serve you and your people. Inspire their heart that they may continue to guide us in our spiritual journey. Protect them from any harm & temptations. Be their comfort, joy & strength whenever challenges and disappointments come their way.

Second Mystery – Let us offer the second mystery for all world leaders. May they always seek the ways of righteousness, justice and mercy. Grant that they may be enabled by your

powerful protection to lead their country with honesty, integrity & compassion.

Third Mystery – Let us offer the third mystery for our country Australia & the Philippines, God Our Father, Guard us from war, calamities, fear & confusion. We pray for our families & ourselves that we become deeply aware of our heritage, our duties and responsibilities as true Christians. May we return these blessings through our works of charity and may we especially the youths show respect to our elders, their parents and less fortunate. Bless us O Lord that we may always fulfill your will so that all things will be restored in Christ.

Fourth Mystery – Let us offer the fourth mystery for the Family Cenacle Groups Australia and all

of its members. By your guidance Mother Mary, may we be faithful stewards of your Sons gifts that we may continue to evangelise and spread the kingdom of God. Give us courage and protect us always with your motherly love.

Fifth Mystery – Let us offer the fifth mystery for all poor souls in purgatory, for the souls of our departed relatives & friends (mention names if needed). Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord, May their soul rest in peace and we pray that one day you will accept them into your kingdom.

After all 5 Mysteries have been recited: -

HAIL HOLY QUEEN

All: Hail Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy; hail our life, our sweetness and our hope. To thee do we cry poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn, then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy towards us. And after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

Leader: Pray for us O Holy Mother of God

Response: That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Leader: Let us pray

All: O God, whose only begotten Son by His life, death and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal salvation. Grant we beseech Thee, that meditating upon these mysteries of the most holy rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord. AMEN

Leader: Let us pray 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary & 1 Glory Be for the intentions of our Holy Father, the Pope.

Leader: Let us now offer our petitions, for every intention we say, Let us pray to the Lord (*pause and wait for members to share their intentions*)

Response: Lord, hear our prayer

THE MEMORARE

All: Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary that never was it known that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your aid or sought intercession was left unaided. Inspired with this confidence we fly unto you, O virgin of virgins, our Mother. To you we come. Before you we stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not our petitions, but in

your clemency, hear and answer us. AMEN

ST MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL

All: Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the malice and snares of the Devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray. And do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into Hell, Satan and all the other evil spirits, who roam about the world, seeking the ruins of souls. AMEN

ANGEL OF GOD

All: Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom his love commits me here. Ever this day be at my side to light and guard, to rule and guide. AMEN



CHAPLET OF THE DIVINE MERCY

Opening Prayer

All: You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelope the whole world and empty yourself out upon us.

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

OUR FATHER

All: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our

trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. AMEN

HAIL MARY

All: Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now, and at the hour of our death. AMEN

On the large bead before each decade:

Leader: Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Response: In atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On the ten small beads of each decade:

Leader: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion.

Response: Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Conclude by repeating three times:

All: Holy God,
Holy Mighty One,
Holy Immortal One,
Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

CLOSING PRAYER:

All: Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion – inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not become despair nor become despondent but with

great confidence submit ourselves to Your Holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Amen.

Our Lord said to Saint Faustina:

All: Encourages souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you... Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death... When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between my Father and the dying person, not as the Just Judge but the Merciful Saviour... Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last home of salvation. Even if there was a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from my infinite mercy. I desire to

grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy... Through the Chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will.

beloved and the souls of the
faithful departed through the
mercy of God rest in peace.

Response: AMEN

Leader: May the presence of God
remain always in our hearts
and mind now and forever, in
the name of the Father, and of
the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Response: AMEN
